this book will be the first account of the development of chinese as a foreign language in the u s as it interacts with the relevant entities in china and beyond there are virtually no systematic retrospective reflections on the field outside of the greater china region and yet over the past decades the field has grown by leaps and bounds and it is critical now that we pause to reflect on what has happened and what we can learn from the past the contributors are among some of the most influential pioneers in the field whose entire academic lives have been dedicated to its development the field of chinese language education in the u s a retrospective of the 20th century is aimed at those who are currently engaged in chinese language education as teachers or as students

calls attention to arts which have developed and flourished in china since the stone age

professor zhiping liang offers a new understanding of chinese legal tradition in this profoundly influential book unlike the available literature using the usual method of legal history research this book attempts to illustrate ancient chinese legal tradition through cultural interpretation the author holds that both the concept and practice of law are meaningful cultural symbols the law reveals not only the life pattern in a specific time and space but also the world of the mind of a specific group of people therefore just as cultures have different types laws embedded in different societies and cultures also have different characters and spirits believing that human experience is often condensed into concepts categories and classifications the author begins his discussion with the analysis of relevant terms and then seeks to understand history by interpreting the interaction and interconnectedness of the words ideas and practices based on the same understanding the author uses modern concepts reflectively and critically consciously exploiting the differences between ancient and contemporary chinese and western concepts to achieve a more realistic understanding of history while avoiding the ethnocentrism and modern centrism common in historical studies

china has experienced the world's fastest economic growth for over a decade it is likely that within a generation china will have the world's largest economy yet at the moment when china looks set to regain its former power serious questions have to be asked about the continuing integrity of china the challenges posed by economic reform succession politics and new forces of political liberalism are compounded by boundary uncertainties as china adopts a strategy of greater interdependence with the regional and global economy the writers of this book analyse the factors that might lead to and that might prevent the break up of china they provide key data about economic activity and external connections of the major regional forces their analysis provides essential reading for those concerned with the prospects for china and the future stability of east asia

this book examines the development of chinese literature journals and social ideologies from 1931 to 1938 combining first hand historical materials historical data and four important literature journals to study the competition and cooperation between various powers such as the kuomintang the ccp the third party and intellectuals this book describes the most influential chinese literature journals and their political background during that period and explains the relations between disparate political and social powers helping to decipher chinese intellectuals cultural positions during this time the author concludes with the provocative thesis that

the common question from the western point of view is of the sort why did china lose its early leadership of productive technologies to europe during the early modern period answers to this seemingly clear enquiry vary from general cultural inwardness to the interferences of imperial governance this collection surveys such theories but alters the issue by raising the notion that chinese technologies did not so much fail as move along a path different from that of europe our second collection on the mindful hand also shifts common ground by querying and modifying common views of the links between knowledge and technique in early modern european development scientific or related knowledge was not brought to technique as a socio cultural gift from an educated elite to the working man rather educated gents practitioners instrument makers craftsfolk and technicians of all kinds intermingled both socially and in terms of the recognition of technical problems as well as in the assemblage of the mental commercial and cognitive resources required to pursue innovative production projects

after more than twenty years of economic and political reform china is a vastly different country to that left by mao almost all the characteristic policies and practices of the maoist era have been abandoned with the goals of revolution in foreign and domestic policy being replaced by an emphasis on economic modernization accompanied by radical social transformation and an increasingly significant international role yet despite these dramatic changes other fundamental features of china s policy remain unchanged this book explores the strategies of reform in china and their implications for its domestic and foreign policies it challenges the misconceptions that no political reforms are taking place and that china is eagerly embracing capitalism it also challenges the view that china does not abide by international norms and practices on military and security matters its contributors all highly respected scholars avoid simple generalisations about the nature of china s politics or future path instead offering comparisons and contrasts between policy areas and regions to create a more complete picture of this complex country

this book the first of a multi volume set on the silk road during the ming dynasty takes a holistic and global view of the origin and development of the silk road the

early encounters between britain and china are best known for igniting the first opium war yet they also produced an enormous archive of writings by britons who spent time in china frustrated with the restrictions imposed by the manchu rulers of the qing empire and unable to live or travel elsewhere apart from canton and macao these diplomats traders missionaries travelers and military officers devoted thousands of pages to understanding china its people and their civilization in china hands and old cantons john m carroll draws on this wealth of memoirs ethnographic studies travel accounts narratives of military action translations and newspaper articles to trace britons wide ranging often thoughtful perspectives on china long before anyone considered going to war they discussed almost everything they saw and speculated about much of what they could not see including the size of china s massive population the extent of infanticide the origins and practice of foot binding and the legality and morality of the opium trade they claimed that only those who had been there could truly understand the middle kingdom and that their firsthand experience gave them and their publications an advantage over those in britain and elsewhere carroll brings a seminal period in the anglo chinese relationship which revolved around tea and opium to life through the words of those who experienced it intimately

in this edited volume a set of issue and country experts tackle questions regarding china s current rise to power within the current international economic and political order the current international system is governed by a western conception of order and based on the primacy of post world war ii rules drawn from liberal models of capitalism and democracy practiced in the us and in western europe in this context the most important and most uncertain questions facing the west over the next decade concern how the eu and the us will respond to china s rapid growth will the transatlantic relationship hold and become stronger faced with this new economic and geopolitical challenge or will the us and the eu an increasingly prominent global player compete for economic and political advantage after a brief introduction laying out the circumstances of china s economic and political rise and the challenges that this poses to the existing international order the book proceeds in three sections the first section provides competing theoretical perspectives on china s rise in a historical context the second section provides a distinctly

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
